Thailand

Thailand offers both an e-visa applied before travel and a visa on arrival for short stays. Which route suits you depends on your passport, trip length and entry point.

BIOMETRICS

Not required before travel

Photograph specification

- 1 35 x 45 mm colour photograph
- 2 White background, taken within 6 months
- 3 Face straight to the camera, no headwear
- 4 No glasses or reflective surfaces

Eligibility checklist

- ☐ Passport valid for at least 6 months
- ☐ Return ticket within the permitted stay period
- ☐ Confirmed accommodation
- ☐ Funds to support the stay

DOCUMENTS TO PREPARE

Complete checklist

REQUIRED FOR EVERY APPLICANT

- ☐ **Passport**
Valid for at least 6 months with 2 blank pages.
- ☐ **Photograph**
One recent 35 x 45 mm photo on a white background.
- ☐ **Confirmed return tickets**
Round-trip booking with dates inside the permitted stay.
- ☐ **Accommodation proof**
Hotel bookings covering the full stay.

FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS

- ☐ **Bank statement**
Last 6 months showing adequate balance for the trip.
- ☐ **Proof of funds for VOA**
Cash or card evidence may be checked at the airport counter.

PURPOSE-SPECIFIC DOCUMENTS

- ☐ **Tourist e-visa**
Itinerary, hotel bookings, bank statements and occupation proof.
- ☐ **Visa on arrival**
Completed arrival form, photograph, confirmed return ticket within 15 days and hotel booking.
- ☐ **Business**
Invitation from the Thai company and a letter from your employer.

Important to know

- Visa on arrival is limited to 15 days and is only available at designated entry points.
- The e-visa suits stays beyond 15 days and avoids airport queues.
- Overstaying carries penalties and affects future entries.
